

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS:

Material Changes have been made to the weigh-in/classification procedure for **EVERY** livestock species. This incomplete summary is for your convenience – **CONSULT THE RULE BOOK FOR FULL CHANGES:**

LAMBS:

Lamb weigh-in will be Wed. evening at 7pm. This will be the official show weight and there will be NO WEIGH BACK. **Lambs MUST WEIGH a minimum of 70 pounds or they will be subject to disqualification.** There will be no variance from this minimum. There is no maximum weight.

GOATS:

Goat weigh-in will commence at the conclusion of the Lamb weigh-in. This will be the official weight and there will be NO WEIGH BACK. **Goats MUST WEIGH at least 50 pounds but not more than 115 pounds or they will be subject to disqualification.** There will be no variance from these weights.

HEIFERS:

- Registered heifers will have papers and tattoo checked Wed evening at 7pm.
- Commercial heifers will weigh-in and classify **THURSDAY MORNING** at 8am. This will be the official show weight and there will be NO WEIGH BACK. There are no minimum or maximum weights for commercial heifers.

STEERS:

Steer weigh-in and classification will commence at the conclusion of the Commercial Heifer classification on **THURSDAY MORNING**. Steers will be called by breeds and the weights recorded will be the official show weight. There will be NO WEIGH BACK. **Steers MUST WEIGH a minimum of 850 pounds or they will be subject to disqualification.** There will be no variance from this weight.

HOGS:

Hog weigh-in and classification will commence at the conclusion of the Steer classification on **THURSDAY MORNING**. Hogs will be called by breeds and the weights recorded will be the official show weight. There will be NO WEIGH BACK. **Hogs MUST WEIGH at least 140 pounds but not more than 290 pounds or they will be subject to disqualification.** There will be no variance from these weights.
